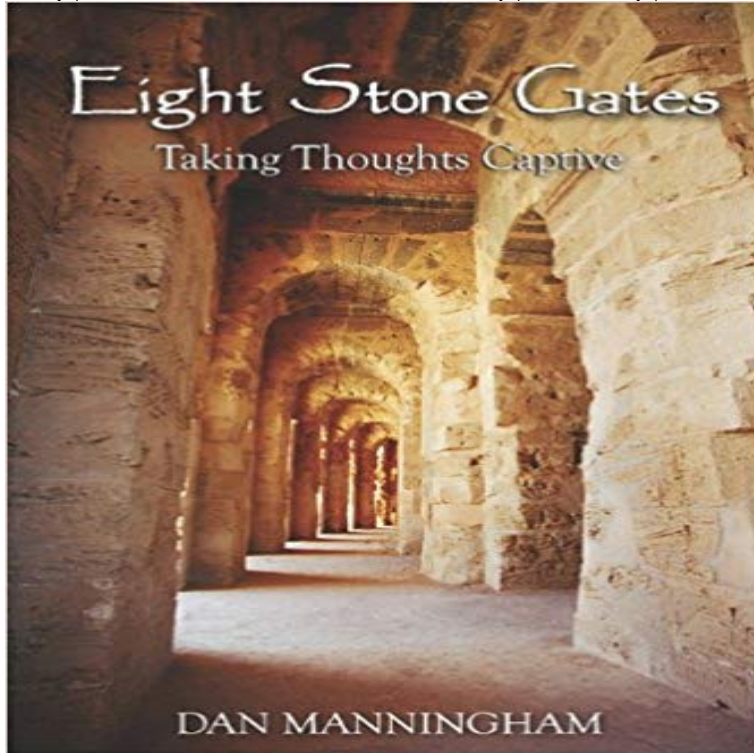


Eight Stone Gates: Taking Thoughts Captive
