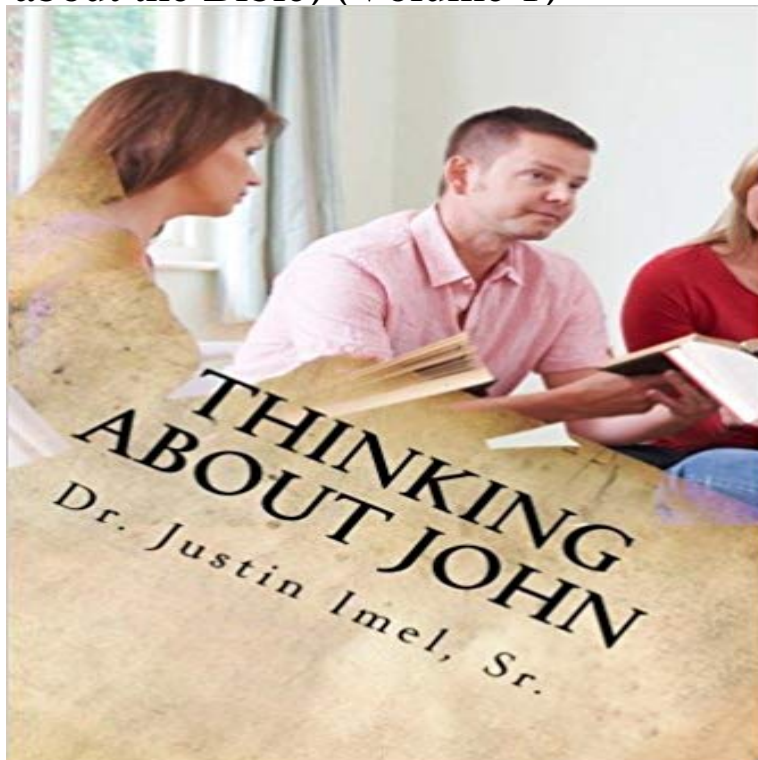


Thinking about John: A Study Guide to the Gospel of John (Thinking about the Bible) (Volume 1)
